---

### PC Information:

Operating System: Windows 2000-SP4, XP-SP2, and Vista 32-bit  
Disc Drive: DVD Drive  
Memory: 512 MB  
Processor: Pentium III or equivalent processor  
QuickTime 7.1.5  
Adobe Reader 6.0

### Running on the PC:

1. Insert the DVD into your DVD drive.
2. The program will begin playing automatically if your computer has the auto-run feature enabled. If auto-run is not enabled, double-click on your "My Computer" icon (also located in your Start menu), and then double-click on the disc icon.

### To view the program's Teacher Resources and credits:

1. If auto-run is enabled on your computer you will first need to click "Exit" while the program is running. Then double-click on your "My Computer" icon, back-click on the disc icon, and select "Explore".
2. Double-click on the credits PDF file to view the credits.
3. Double-click on the "main" folder and then the "resources" folder. Select a Teacher Resources PDF to view.

2. To view credits, double-click on the credits PDF file.
3. To view the Teacher Resources, double-click on the "main" folder and then the "resources" folder. Select a Teacher Resources PDF to view.
